### Judges Selection Guidelines:

- Minimum of 5, maximum of 7 competition judges. It is recommended that three of the judges be certified.
- At least one judge must be a novice who has never judged a pageant in the Miss America System (Teen or Miss).
- Different panel each year; Judges may not judge the same pageant in two consecutive years.
- A judge may judge up to 2 State and up to 4 Local MAOT pageants in one pageant year.
- Judges must be at least 21 years of age.
- Sponsors, vendors, coaches, or contributors (financial or in-kind), as well as their employees and family members may not judge a pageant they support.
- Anyone that is related to a contestant through blood relation, marriage, through business contacts (including contestant's family), or social contacts (including with contestant's family) may not judge that contestant.
- Husband and wife teams/couples are not permitted to serve on the same panel of judges.
- Two people residing at the same address are not permitted to serve on the same panel of judges.
- Relatives of State/Local board members may not judge the State/Local Pageant for which the relative serves as a board member.
- Parents or relatives of a contestant at the Local level may not judge Local Pageants in the state in which the contestant is competing.
- Parents or relatives of a contestant competing in a State Pageant may not judge Local or State pageants in any state, regardless of the State in which the contestant is competing.
- Business associates are not permitted to serve on the same panel of judges.
- A former contestant may never judge anyone with whom she previously competed.
- A former "Miss" titleholder cannot judge a contestant who simultaneously held the same "Teen" title.
- No Local Executive Director or any other Board Member may judge their former Teen (or Miss) titleholder.
- No one may judge a contestant in any phase of competition who the prospective judge has previously trained.
- Parents or family members of a Local, State or National Representative may not judge any Local, State or National Pageant affiliated with the Miss America Organization or Miss America's Outstanding Teen, Inc. during their daughter's year of service.
